



Factsheet Container Road Transportation Austria

Maximum allowable dimensions of the truck and chassis, incl. container:

Height	4,00 meters
Width	2,55 meters
Length	16,50 meters

Maximum allowed weight of total combination (Incl. Container Weight):

Vehicles consisting of 5 axles	40,00 Tons
Vehicles in intermodal (combined) transportation*	44,00 Tons

* The exceptional max. weight of 44 Tons is only allowed for intermodal (combined) transportation (barge-truck and/or rail-truck).

In general you can calculate with the following weights:

- Combination of truck and chassis (without container)	14 Tons
- 20' container standard	2,4 Tons
- 40' container standard	3,8 Tons
- 40' container highcube	3,9 Tons
- 45' container highcube	4,8 Tons
- 20' reefer standard	2,9 Tons
- 40' reefer highcube	4,4 Tons

Driving restrictions freight vehicles

Austria has a wide variety of driving bans. Austria has national driving bans due to public holidays, weekends, nights, holidays, toll evasion and freight vehicle dosing. In addition, Tyrol, for example, has various driving bans for driving in a certain euro class, during the night or with a certain load.

On public holidays, the driving ban applies from 00:00 till 22:00, during the weekend from Saturday afternoon 15:00 till Sunday evening 22:00 and in addition there is a night driving ban on all roads from 22:00 till 05:00.

Road tax

Users of motorways with freight vehicles obliged to pay a kilometer charge. The kilometer rate depends on:

- The Euro class
- CO2 emissions
- The number of axles of the vehicle
